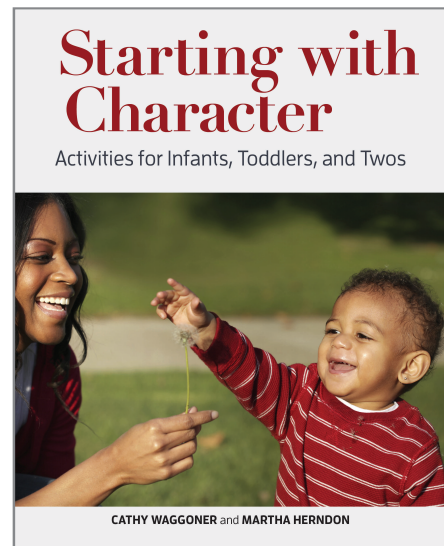
The activities and lessons facilitate the development of key character traits in children:
